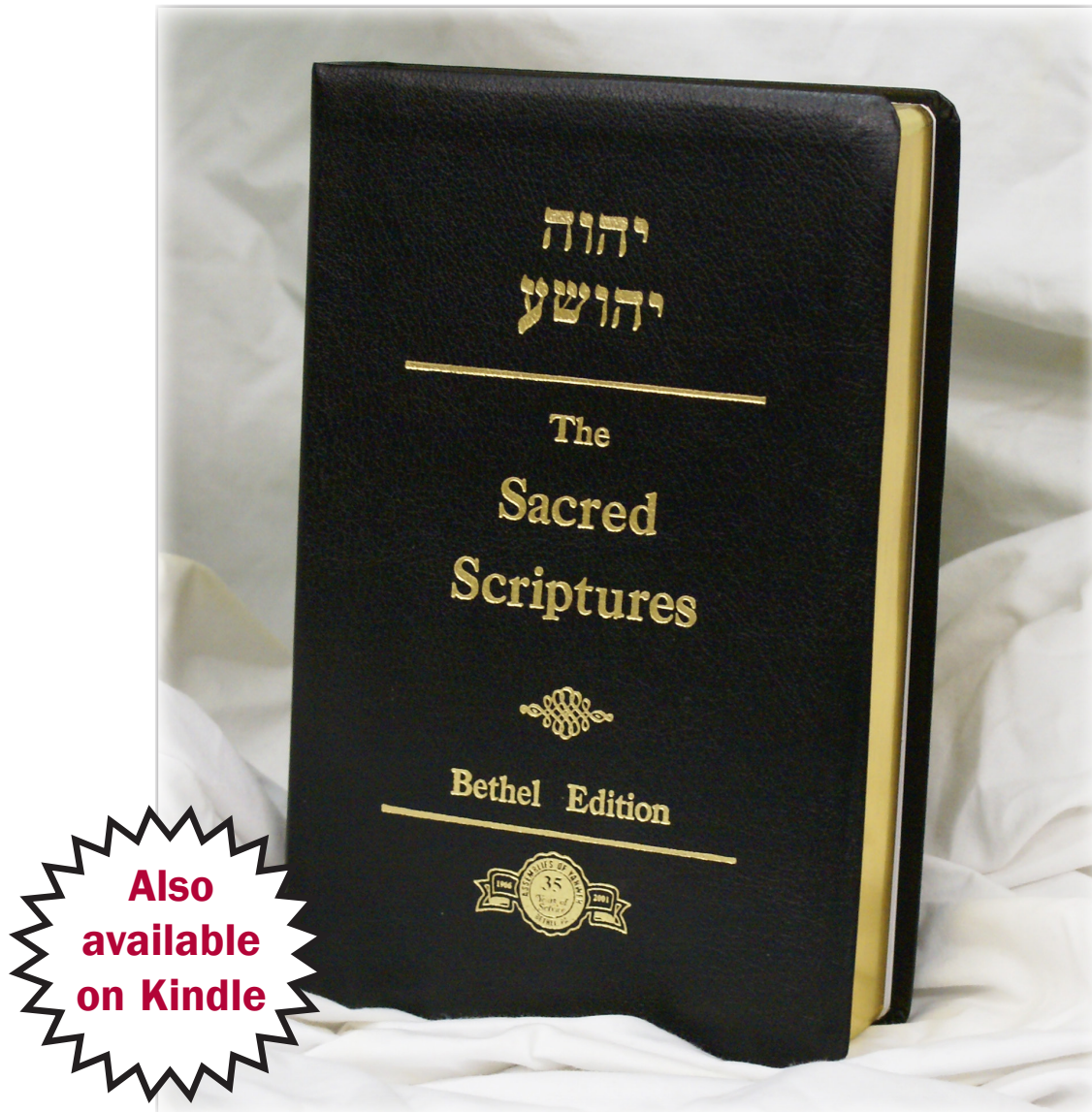


The Sacred Scriptures

We have restored the Sacred Name, Yahweh (the Tetragrammaton), and proper titles to the English text of the Old Testament, as well as returning the Name of Yahshua, our Savior, to the text of the New Testament.

The Sacred Scriptures, Bethel Edition, is based upon the translation work of the **American Standard Version**, 1901, known as the most accurate English version ever put into print. It maintains the delicate balance necessary to provide a very accurate, literal translation, while preserving the majesty of expression of the original texts.

In this edition, we have sought to eliminate the Shakespearean English which is no longer familiar in modern usage, and we have tried to be faithful in rendering the original texts (as closely as we can return to them).

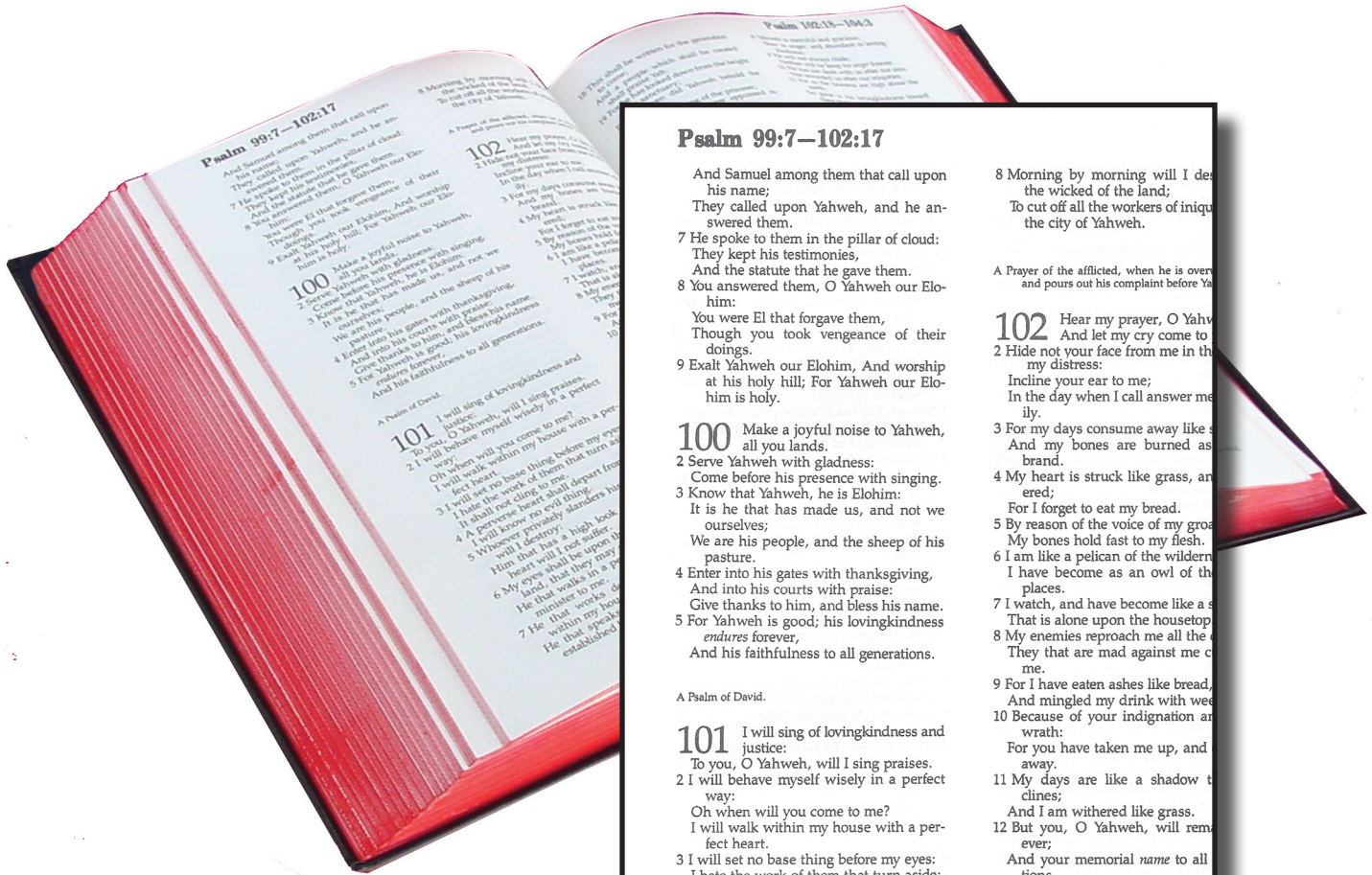

6 I am like a pelican of the wilderness;
I have become as an owl of the places.
7 I watch, and have become like a screech owl:
That is alone upon the housetop.
8 My enemies reproach me all the day long:
They that are mad against me curse me.
9 For I have eaten ashes like bread,
And mingled my drink with weeping.
10 Because of your indignation and wrath:
For you have taken me up, and thrown me away.
11 My days are like a shadow that declines;
And I am withered like grass.
12 But you, O Yahweh, will remember forever;
And your memorial name to all generations.
13 You will arise, and have mercy on Zion;
For it is time to have pity upon her:
Yes, the set time is come.
14 For your servants take pleasure in stones,
And have pity upon her dust.
15 So the nations shall fear the name of Yahweh,
And all the kings of the earth you shall glorify.
16 For Yahweh has built up Zion;
He has appeared in his glory;
17 He has regarded the prayer of the afflicted,
And has not despised their prayer.
